Spring 2010

News Update

We are emerging from **one of the** coldest winters for years, but Spring is now around the corner and it's time to get the clubs re-gripped and the swing back in motion. As economies on both sides of the Atlantic move cautiously out of recession, golf travellers will find great value this year in Britain and Ireland. The strong dollar will make a succession of tempting offers by golf clubs and hotels very affordable, but as demand rises to balance supply we expect prices to firm later in the year. Our advice therefore is to book early in order to capture savings now.

In recent years a number of fabulous new courses have opened and are maturing into top tracks — Loch Lomond and its neighbour, The Carrick Course; Sir Nick Faldo's Irish masterpieces at Ballyliffin and Lough Erne; the Renaissance Course by Tom Doak in East Lothian near Edinburgh; and Kyle Phillips' Kingsbarns to name but a few.

Machrihanish Dunes, the first genuine links course to be built on the west coast of Scotland for 100 years and designed by David McLay Kidd, has been lauded by Links Magazine as one of the "Top New International Courses". It has also achieved 21st place in Golfweek's



"Best New Modern Courses of Great Britain and Ireland". Kidd's layout features six greens and five tees right on the Atlantic coast, all with spectacular views out over the Paps of Jura and the north coast of Ireland. When he first saw the site, Kidd identified 23 "natural" holes, and he picked his favourite 18. The course is the first in Scotland to be built on a **Site of Special Scientific Interest** and no carts are allowed because of the protection afforded by legislation. With high quality golf cottages under construction and some already completed, a tempting

offer allows two nights B & B and one round on the new course from just £175 per person April through October. Old Tom Morris's Machrihanish itself is, of course, close by and Dunaverty, a little-played hidden gem just south of Campbeltown, completes a trio of excellent links courses on the scenic Mull of Kintyre.

We have expounded already on the delights of **Castle Stuart Golf Links** near Inverness and a variety of recent articles in golf publications demonstrate widespread agreement with our views. To kick-start the new season a consortium of hotel and courses are combining to offer a great deal in April, which features this fabulous new course. Three



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nights at the newly-refurbished Royal Golf Hotel in Dornoch and one round at Royal Dornoch plus two rounds at Castle Stuart can be had for as little as \$555 per person. This is roughly the same price as the regular green fees in the main season. Interestingly, in a typical year, the north of Scotland enjoys more sunshine hours and less rainfall in April than it does in September. Note that the actual Castle Stuart itself is not part of the golf complex. The original house was completed in 1625 by James Stuart, Earl of Moray, but then suffered 300 years of neglect before being restored to its



present glory. Voted second best castle in Europe in 2008 by TripAdvisor, it has eight sumptuous bedrooms and can be booked for exclusive-use by family or corporate parties. It also takes individual bookings.

Built to stage **The Ryder Cup in 2010**, the "**Twenty Ten**" course at **Celtic Manor** in Wales opened for play in July 2007. The first course to be built specifically for golf's greatest team tournament, it measures 7,493 yards off the back tees and has a par of 71. Water

hazards feature on half of its holes although many of the earlier holes have a links-like feel with some long rough and greenside swales. The middle section of the course reveals the full extent of the watery challenge, before a tough finishing stretch culminates in a real sting in the tail at the 18th. Watching the Ryder Cup this year would be much more fun if you had already played the course and if you decide to visit Celtic Manor you can enjoy three championship courses. Robert Trent Jones Senior's Roman Road Course opened in 1995 and has hosted the Wales Open on several

occasions, while **Colin Montgomerie's** design
completes the trio.
Traditionalists will rejoice that **Royal Porthcawl** and **Southerndown** are just a short drive away.

Those who don't know Wales may be surprised to learn that, for a small country, it has a lot to offer: 641 castles, 687 miles of coastline and around 200 golf courses for a start.

Exceptional value for money is on offer too, with rounds at **Royal St David's** – one of the flagship championship links courses in the Principality – costing under \$100!

And the scenery in places is quite spectacular.

Ireland, too, has some great value golf available. For example, **Enniscrone** is one of the best courses we've ever played and the green fees are under \$100. **Carne**, **Ballyliffin**, **Rosapenna** and **Co Sligo** are all modestly-priced as well and **Lahinch** is offering special rates

throughout the summer.

And let's not forget England.

Woodhall Spa is the home of the English Golf Union and of the Hodgkin Course, ranked the best inland course in England by Golf Magazine. The cost of the green fee? Less than \$100!
